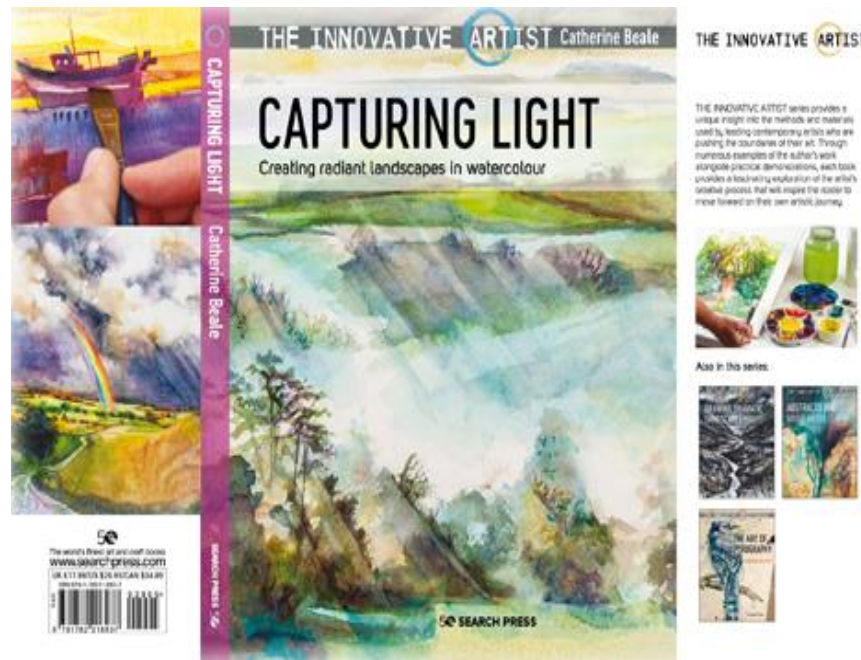


8th April - Catherine Beale's 'gravity painted' watercolours:

Do you want to paint with watercolours but are worried about their scary reputation? Or have you started painting in this great medium but want to loosen up your techniques and be more expressive? This painting retreat is a masterclass designed for a maximum of eight painters with you in mind.

Catherine will bust myths and demonstrate how watercolour is actually forgiving. She will help you to create several 'postcards from the sea' and a larger painting to take key techniques back home with you and fall in love with the 'whoosh' of cascading paint and bright colours.

Begin with warm up exercises, continue with small postcard paintings before breaking for supper and plenty of arty discussion. Arrive on Saturday to create your little masterpiece and enjoy a delicious lunch before reviewing your work and hearing trouble shooting ideas to add your finishing touches.



Catherine Beale is an award-winning painter with a practice spanning nearly thirty years. She is a member of the Society of Women Artists, exhibits regularly at London's Mall Galleries and at Bath Society of Artists Annual Exhibition. She tutors at the RWA Bristol and Cornwall School of Art and is a published author. Right now Catherine is writing five articles for The Artist Magazine (publication mid-2024).
